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
How to change engine oil and filter on **Toyota Yaris Mk2** – replacement guide

important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

TOYOTA Yaris / Vios Saloon (_P9_) 1.5 (NCP93), TOYOTA STARLET (KP6_) 1.0, TOYOTA STARLET (KP6_) 1.2 S, TOYOTA Starlet Estate (KP6_) 1.0, TOYOTA STARLET (_P7_) 1.0, TOYOTA STARLET (_P8_) 1.3 12V KAT, TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E7_) 1.3 (KE70), TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E8_) 1.3, TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E8_) 1.6, TOYOTA COROLLA FX Compact (E8B) 1.6 GT 16V (AE82_), TOYOTA COROLLA (_E8_) 1.3, TOYOTA COROLLA (_E8_) 1.6, TOYOTA COROLLA Coupe (AE86) 1.6 GT 16V, TOYOTA COROLLA (_E9_) 1.6, TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E9_) 1.6, (+ 469)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – TOYOTA YARIS MK2. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Torque wrench
- Drive socket # 14
- Oil filter cup socket 65-14F

- Ratchet wrench
- Oil drain pan
- Funnel
- Fender cover

BUY TOOLS

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- · Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Please note: all work on the car Toyota Yaris Mk2 should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1

Open the hood.



2

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



3

Unscrew the oil filler plug.



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Pull up the oil dipstick.



Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Professionals recommend:

- The vehicle must be on even keel, and if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.
- Put a waste oil container with at least 5 l capacity under the drainage hole.



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7 Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.



o Drain the used oil.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Caution! The oil may be hot.
- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

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Clean the oil filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Unscrew the oil filter. Use the 65-14F socket. Use a ratchet wrench.



Remove the oil filter.



Clean the oil filter seat. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.



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15 Install a new oil filter.

Tighten the oil filter. Remember to observe the recommended tightening torque. Use the 65-14F socket. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 24 Nm torque.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Tip from AUTODOC:

• Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



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Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #14. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



Lower the car.



Remove the oil filler cap.



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22 Insert the funnel.



Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 3.2 l.



AUTODOC recommends:

- Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.
- Check the oil level using the dipstick. Top up oil if necessary.



Please note!

• The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.

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25 Install the oil filler cap.



Tighten the oil filler cap.



Run the engine for a few minutes.

After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.

Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. AUTODOC recommends:

 Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.

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Check the oil level 5 minutes after the stop of the engine operation using a dipstick and add oil if necessary.



Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, carefully tighten them up.

Remove the fender protection cover.



Close the hood.

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Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.



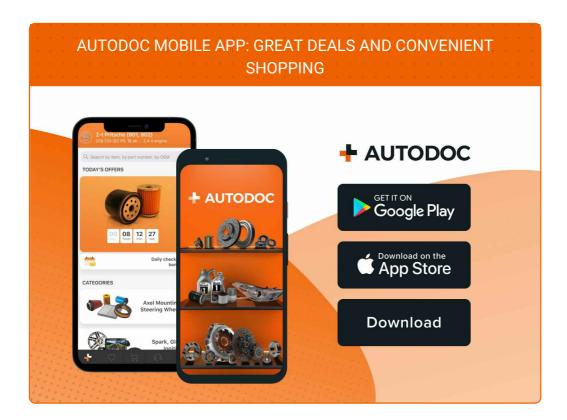
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
