and filter on **Toyota Yaris**
Mk2 – replacement guide

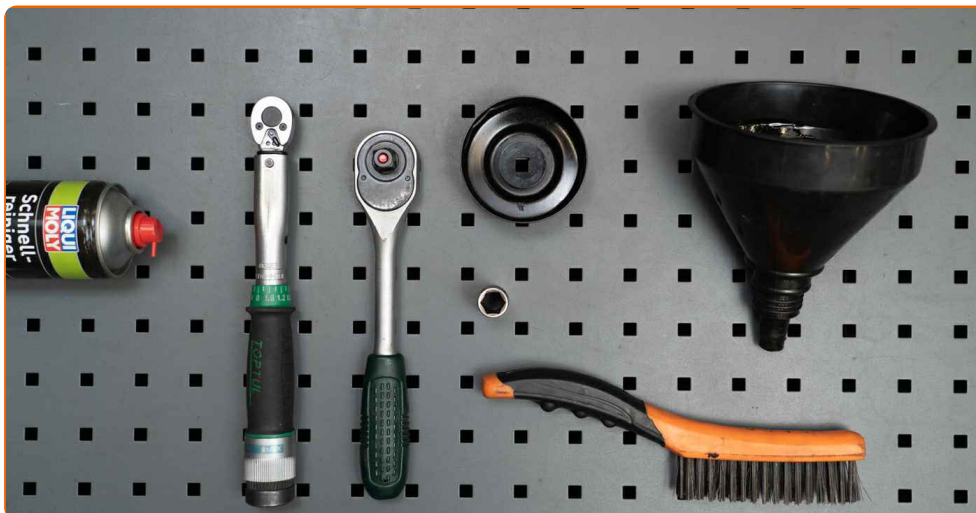
i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

TOYOTA Yaris / Vios Saloon (_P9_) 1.5 (NCP93), TOYOTA STARLET (KP6_) 1.0, TOYOTA STARLET (KP6_) 1.2 S, TOYOTA Starlet Estate (KP6_) 1.0, TOYOTA STARLET (_P7_) 1.0, TOYOTA STARLET (_P8_) 1.3 12V KAT, TOYOTA Corolla Estate (_E7_) 1.3 (KE70), TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E8_) 1.3, TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E8_) 1.6, TOYOTA COROLLA FX Compact (E8B) 1.6 GT 16V (AE82_), TOYOTA COROLLA (_E8_) 1.3, TOYOTA COROLLA (_E8_) 1.6, TOYOTA COROLLA Coupe (AE86) 1.6 GT 16V, TOYOTA COROLLA (_E9_) 1.6, TOYOTA COROLLA Liftback (_E9_) 1.6, (+ 469)

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

REPLACEMENT: ENGINE OIL AND FILTER – TOYOTA YARIS MK2. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Torque wrench
- Drive socket # 14
- Oil filter cup socket 65-14F
- Ratchet wrench
- Oil drain pan
- Funnel
- Fender cover

BUY TOOLS

Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Replace the oil filter every time when changing motor oil.
- Wear gloves to prevent contact with hot liquid.
- Please note: all work on the car – Toyota Yaris Mk2 – should be done with the engine switched off.

CARRY OUT REPLACEMENT IN THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

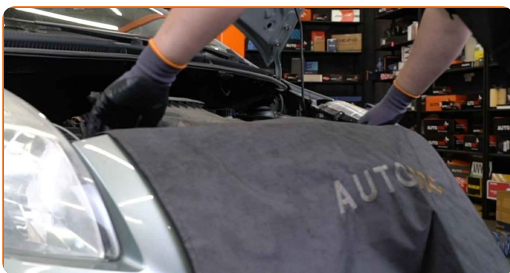

Open the hood.



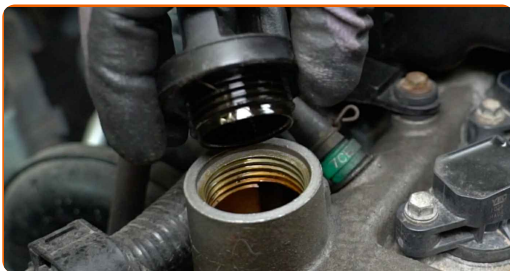

Use a fender protection cover to prevent damaging paintwork and plastic parts of the car.



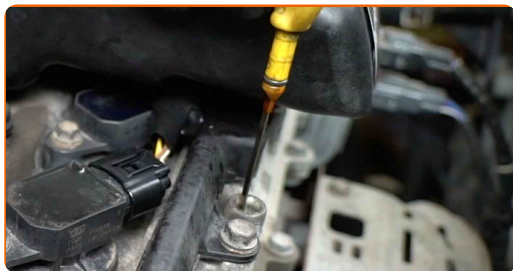

Unscrew the oil filler plug.

Pull up the oil dipstick.



5

Lift the car using a jack or place it over an inspection pit.

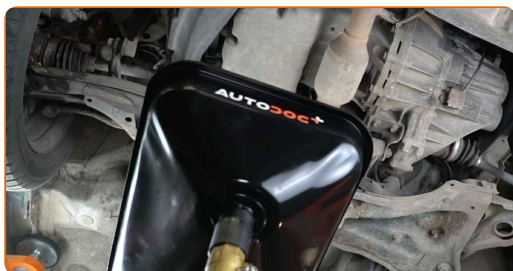


Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Professionals recommend:

- The vehicle must be on even keel, and if it is at an angle, the drain plug must be at the lowest point.

Put a waste oil container with at least 5 l capacity under the drainage hole.



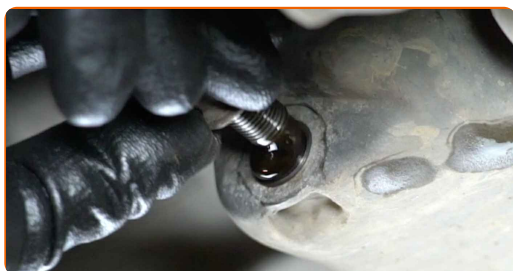

Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use a wire brush. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



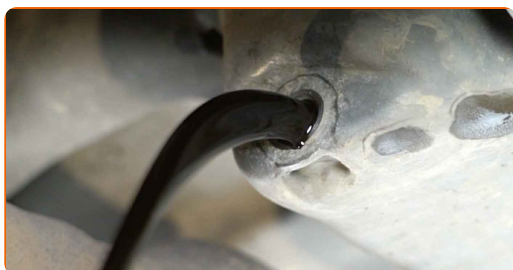

Unscrew the drain plug. Use a drive socket #14. Use a ratchet wrench.

Drain the used oil.



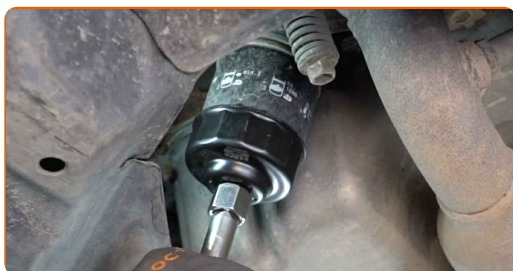
Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Caution! The oil may be hot.
- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

- 10** Clean the oil filter. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



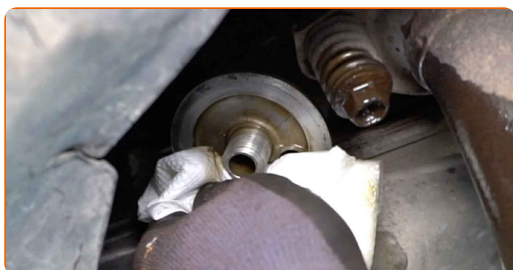
- 11** Unscrew the oil filter. Use the 65-14F socket. Use a ratchet wrench.



- 12** Remove the oil filter.



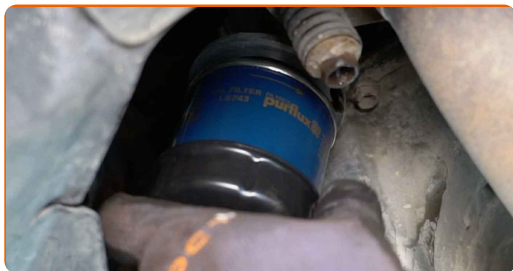
- 13** Clean the oil filter seat. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- 14** Lubricate the rubber seal of the new filter with a little amount of fresh oil.



15 Install a new oil filter.



16 Tighten the oil filter. Remember to observe the recommended tightening torque. Use the 65-14F socket. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 24 Nm torque.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Tip from AUTODOC:

- Wait until the oil has completely drained from the drainage hole.

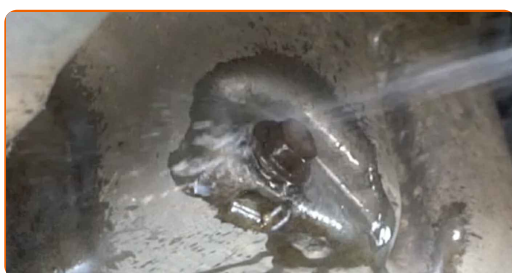
17 Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



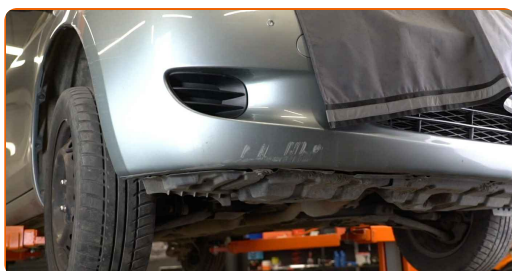
- 18** Screw in the new drainage plug and tighten it. Use a drive socket #14. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 30 Nm torque.



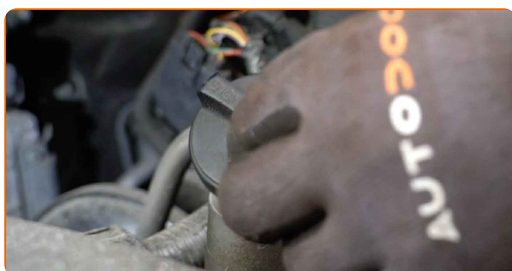
- 19** Clean the area of the oil pan drainage hole. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



- 20** Lower the car.



- 21** Remove the oil filler cap.

Insert the funnel.

Pour oil into the engine through the filler. Required amount of oil: 3.2 l.

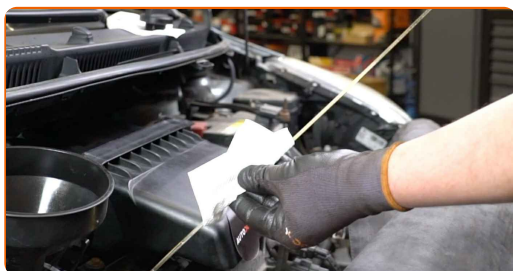


AUTODOC recommends:

- Use the oil recommended by the manufacturer.

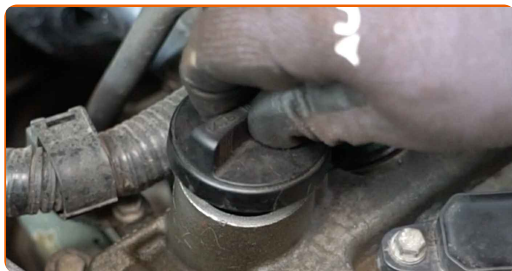
Check the oil level using the dipstick. Top up oil if necessary.



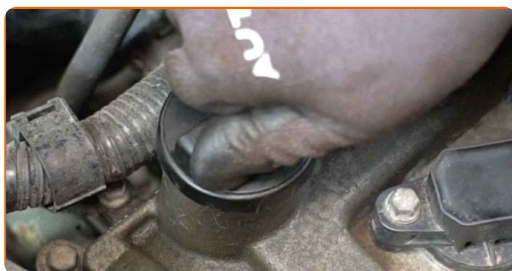
Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.

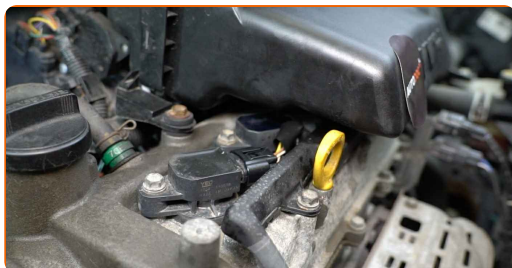
25 Install the oil filler cap.



26 Tighten the oil filler cap.



27 Run the engine for a few minutes.



28 After the oil pressure warning light goes out, stop the engine.

Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. AUTODOC recommends:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.

- 29 Check the oil level 5 minutes after the stop of the engine operation using a dipstick and add oil if necessary.



Please note!

- The oil level should be between the Min and Max marks.
- Make sure that the oil filler cap is properly tightened.
- Check the threaded plug of the drainage hole and the oil filter seal for tightness. If necessary, carefully tighten them up.

- 30 Remove the fender protection cover.



- 31 Close the hood.



Replacement: engine oil and filter – Toyota Yaris Mk2. Tip from AUTODOC experts:

- Note that oil pressure warning light, which indicates insufficient pressure in the lubrication system, may be on for a longer time than usual. After a few seconds, the oil will fill all the channels, and the light will go out.
- To protect the environment from pollution, be sure to dispose of the used filters at special collection points.
