


How to replace a spark plug on Honda Jazz GD

Carry out replacement in the following order:



Remove the engine cover






Disconnect the ignition coil plugs

Unscrew the ignition coil fastening screws.

Remove the spark plugs with a spark plug wrench and place them on a work surface in the order of installing in the engine.

Apply a thin layer of special grease on the thread surface of new spark plugs.


Screw new spark plugs and tighten them.
