


How to replace a filter element in the fuel filter on Opel Astra H

Carry out replacement in the following order:

1

Open the hood

Disconnect the fuel sensor wiring from the fuel filter

Loosen the fuel supply lines fastening to the fuel filter.




Disconnect the fuel supply lines from the fuel filter.

Unscrew the fuel filter cover.






Remove the filter element from the filter housing





Remove the old sealing ring.




Install new O-rings of the filter element.




Install a new filter element into the holder, and then the entire assembly into the case, aligning the element upper part with the housing.












Connect the fuel supply lines to the fuel filter and tighten the fasteners.
